Several weeks ago, I was sitting alone in our school library praying and glanced up at the bookshelf that holds Bibles and related things. I said, "Jesus, if You walked into this room right now, I would be so ashamed for You to see this shelf. All of these books SHOULD be in the hands of people who need to know You!" So, since I have every child in the school in my Library classes every week, I began giving Bibles away to those who wanted one. There was a set of about 100 small booklets that contained only the Book of John. I gave one to each of my 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students, and we began going through it together, word by word. This has been an amazing opportunity to teach the Word to these kids, who will then have the understanding and the tools to teach others.

Thank you to all of you who faithfully pray for us daily. Your prayers have moved mountains for this work in Honduras.

Pray that the government would allow us to take children again. They shut that down all over Honduras in 2018. Oscar is in line to meet with the new president about this, but she has much more pressing matters happening right now, so it may be a while.

Also, pray for funding for our kids to go to our school next year – we need about \$55,000. This pays for matricula and tuition for the whole year for our fifty kids who are still in our school. Thirty of our kids are now in college in Honduras and the US. The rest work for us. We have almost 500 students between the two schools. Amazing Grace! Folks swarmed to come to our schools when we were given permission to have kids on campus after almost two years online. What an opportunity it has been to share Jesus with all of them and their families, as well as provide them with an excellent education.

word each Monday at the Spanish School morning devotions and on Tuesday at the Bilingual School. The last Friday of each month, we have joint staff devotions with both schools where he gives a word from the Lord that we all need to hear. It is wonderful!

One of our children, Josue David, who takes seriously almost everything Tio Oscar tells him, has begun inviting people to church, because Oscar told him to. Our school receptionist informed me that the reason she started coming was because of David's invitation. She said he looks for her to arrive each Sunday and promptly gets up and joins her. David's teacher told me a similar story. David keeps inviting her to come, and when she does not show up, he asks her Monday morning why not. She asked him why he wants her to come, and he told her it is because he loves her, and because Tio Oscar told him to invite people. "A little child shall lead them."
