



“Summer, Summer, Summertime!”


Summer is in full swing and we are loving every incredibly hot moment of it. It has been wonderful, so far, as several teams have made their way here and blessed our kids so much.

School News From Mary

Happy Belated Fourth of July, H2H Family!!

It has been a great month. Our English School finished the year. The Spanish School got a new ESL teacher, Miss Cesia. They complete their year in November. For our kids, the Summer Camp at the village is in full swing, overseen at the boys' house by 4 of our young teen/adult men, and at the girls' house, 4 of our young teen/adult women.

Our Spanish School just made it to the half-way mark. They took the little kids on a field trip recently. Some of our H2H children attend this school, led by the very capable Miss Iris as director. There are 120 children in this school from grades 1-12. I was blessed to teach ESL to the older kids since February when they commenced. When I went to the US to visit my family there, Miss Cesia took over and is doing a fantastic job.

God continues to bless His work here with people and funds. We have had back to back volunteer teams from the US here since mid-May, and they will continue throughout the summer. At our English School, repairs and new construction are underway, with the addition of another classroom for the Pre-School wing. Our Library has found a new home and is being outfitted as I write this. Please pray for God to bring His teachers to fill the openings we have for next year, which begins in August.

Thank you to everyone who responded to our need for backpacks and school supplies. We still need a few more backpacks, and more school supplies and uniform jeans and shoes. (see needs lists) Please continue to pray for the needs Amy has mentioned. We all need to be vigilant and armored-up, as we move forward as God leads. We love you all, and thank God for you daily.

There are still many fun teams and activities prepared for this summer. We ask for your prayers for those teams.
