I was honored to be joined by retired H2H Board Members Dean & Rachel King, longtime supporters Ken & Linnea Zednik, and soon to be US host of Luis Gustavo, Phil Jasa on this visit to prepare the village for Christmas and love on the kids. A gift bag plus a separate clothing bag with a new outfit – shoes, socks, underwear, jeans & shirt were organized for

each child. This process was made much easier this year by the amazing pre-sorting job that Lisa Closner and Chris Himm did while they were packing the suitcases for us to carry the gifts to the village. Thank you so much Lisa & Chris!

The new outfits are proudly worn to the Christmas dinner that we hold for all who are involved with the ministry in Honduras: our kids; our workers and their families; our teachers and our doctors. The kids will dress up in their new clothes again on Christmas Eve for our celebration at the village when the gift bags are passed out.



There is a lot of excitement among the children around birthday celebrations. Whenever I visit the village one of the first questions the kids ask me is whether or not we're celebrating birthdays during my visit. When I tell them that the celebration is planned, they first tell me their birthdate (to make sure I know we're celebrating their day) and then they ask when the celebration is. From that point on they ask me about the celebration again each day just to be sure nothing has changed, and this goes on until the birthday celebration



takes place. As the ministry celebrates birthdays quarterly a celebration for the 23 kids who have birthdays in the 4th quarter was needed. After passing out gifts, praying for the kids and singing happy birthday, Hondurans like to top off the celebration with a piece of cake and a cup of pop. Girls' House-mom Lourdes loves to bake, and she did her usual marvelous job making the cakes for us again.

In addition to working with the kids to write letters to their sponsors and decorating the Christmas trees, the team helped the kids make Christmas cookies. Every year the kids have a blast rolling dough, cutting cookies and decorating them. This year Linnea brought some sprinkles and they were a hit with the kids. The house moms also got in on the action and it was fun to see them smile while they rolled out their dough & cut their cookies.



At the end of the day, lots of cookies were made (we used 16 pounds of flour to make the dough), lots of frosting was spread and lots of flour wound up everywhere – on the cookies, on the floor, on the kids...

All in all, a good time was had by all.
