In fact, there are so many schools participating, 3 parades are held to accommodate all of them. This year we paraded on September 14th. We combined our two schools, Spanish and Bilingual, for the event. Almost 300 of us marched down main street to the music of our new band!

In addition to wanting the kids under our care to be computer literate we also want to expose them to possible careers in website & software development. So last Spring we applied for a grant of new computers for the school. We were chosen for the grant and the computers arrived this month from Dubai! The monitors, keyboards and mice are coming in a couple weeks from China. The power cords are arriving from San Francisco via UPS. Talk about God having the whole world working together to bless us!!!

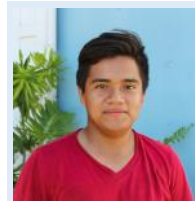

It's time to update you on our adult children. Many have graduated from High School and have either gone on to college, trades schools, or jobs.

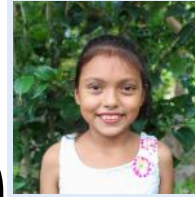
- Felipe is working on a ship that travels the world.

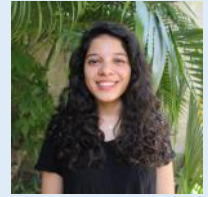
Adonis - Age 20



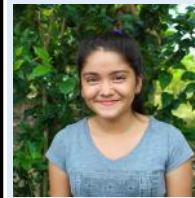
