Our Spanish School began their school year on Feb. 13th, just in time for Valentine's Day! By week's end they had almost 300 students in grades K-12 in attendance!

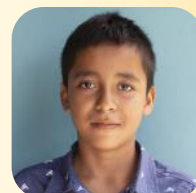


CUPCAKE FUN!!
